1. **Participants must be a member of 4-H to be eligible for 4-H Day contests.** For information on becoming a 4-H member contact your county Extension Office.
2. Registration of participants must precede the judging. Registration will be held at each contest site beginning at 9 a.m. Contest sites will be posted on the fence outside the office building across from Harper Stadium. Registration will end at 10 a.m.
3. All activities will begin at 10:00 a.m., **Wednesday, September 29, 2010.**
4. The participant may enter only one 4-H activity on this day.
5. Individual scores will determine placing.
6. Each activity chair will be responsible for class composition.
7. All 4-H activities will award premiums in a junior division (ages 9-13 years) and a senior division (ages 14-19 years).

**The contest will consist of the following three phases:**

1. Livestock Feed Identification
2. Livestock Production and Showing Equipment Identification
3. Breed Identification (Swine, Beef and Sheep)

In the Livestock Feed Identification phase participants will identify common feeds in our region. The Livestock Production and Showing Equipment Identification will consist of common tools used in modern livestock production practices and in the show ring. The Breed Identification phase will include breeds within the beef, swine and sheep species. Photographs will be used for breed identification.
