SPECIAL AWARD: A \$250.00 scholarship will be awarded upon college enrollment to the exhibitor selling the Grand Champion Broiler Flock. The exhibitor selling the Reserve Grand Champion Broiler Flock will receive a \$150.00 scholarship. These scholarships are donated by Arkansas-Oklahoma Regional Education and Promotion Association, Inc.

OK Farms, Fort Smith, Arkansas, will present a trophy and banner to the exhibitor of the Grand Champion Broiler Pen.

Entries in this department are open only to exhibitors who comply with Rule No. 40. **Exhibitor statement on the back of Junior and Pee Wee Poultry entry form must be completed and returned.**

1. Broilers must be ordered by County agents and Vo-Ag instructors prior to June 30th using forms distributed by each state chair. Each 4-H or FFA member must receive 25 birds. Forms will be distributed to each county agent and school Vo-Ag instructor in the counties listed in rule No. 40 of the catalog. If you have not received a form by May 1, please contact the broiler project chair for your state - Arkansas – Jesse Bocksnick – phone: 479-484-7737 or email jbocksnick@uaex.edu. Oklahoma – Marty Green – phone: 918-696-2253 or email marty.green@okstate.edu.

2. Broilers will be wing banded and distributed at Kay Rodgers Park on Friday, August 6, 2010 and must be picked up by County agents or Vo-Ag instructors on August 7. If unable to pick up your birds, you may authorize someone else to accept the birds by sending a letter on Extension or school letterhead stating the name of the person who is authorized to pick up your birds. Jesse Bocksnick or Marty Green will notify County agents and Vo-Ag instructions by letter as to time assigned for pick up of birds.

3. Broilers not wing banded will be ineligible to show.

4. Each 4-H or FFA member participating in this project is responsible for completing entry forms, with signatures and returning them to the fair office by the August 15, 2009 entry deadline. Entry form should be accompanied by a signed exhibitor statement as indicated above. Participants are exempt from entry fees for this project.

5. Check in broilers Friday, September 24, 8 A.M. TO 8 P.M. Broiler check in deadline is Saturday, September 25, 12 noon.

6. An entry is one pen of three broilers (either sex). Broilers will be supplied by OK Farms, Fort Smith, Arkansas. Broilers will be 7 weeks of age at time of show.

7. Only one pen of broilers may be entered by each exhibitor.

8. All broilers become property of the Arkansas-Oklahoma State Fair in lieu of entry fee.

9. The Grand and Reserve Champion, plus 3rd thru 9th place broiler pens will be sold in the Junior Livestock Auction with the receipts going to exhibitor.
