The show will be a carrier-type show for one day, Sunday, Sept. 26, 2010. Judging will begin promptly at 10 a.m. Exhibitors must use Gate 4.

RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

1. ALL rabbits must be **permanently** tattooed in the LEFT EAR prior to show.
2. Substitutions will only be allowed within the class, as the judging order will be set up prior to the show. All ear number changes must be registered with the secretary before 9 a.m. the judging starts at 10 a.m.
3. Entries in this department are eligible only to exhibitors 9-19 years of age who comply with Rule No. 40.
4. Exhibitors must comply with all general rules and regulations.

SECTION B

American, Giant Angora, Bevern, Californian, Champagne de Arc, Checkered Giant, Giant and American Chinchilla, Cinnamon, Creme de Argent, Flemish Giant, Hotot English Lop, New Zealand (red, black or white), Palomino, Satin, Silver Fox and French Lop.

- Class 1. Sr. Buck (over 8 months of age)
- Class 2. Sr. Doe (over 8 months of age)
- Class 3. Intermediate Buck (6 to 8 months of age)
- Class 4. Intermediate Doe (6 to 8 months of age)
- Class 5. Jr. Buck (under 6 months of age)
- Class 6. Jr. Doe (under 6 months of age)

SECTION C

MEAT PENS (Pens shall consist of three rabbits of the same breed and variety, under 10 weeks of age and minimum 3 lbs., maximum 5 lbs.)

- Class 1. Meat Pen (3) - can be crossbred and will be weighed in the presence of the judge.
- Class 2. Meat Pen (single fryer).

AWARDS
