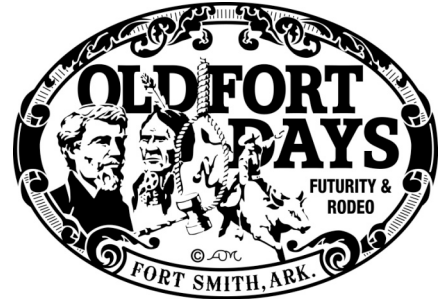


2010 Old Fort Days Rodeo Schedule of Events
